HCC Uniform Policy

At Heatherton Christian College, we like to see students taking care and pride in their appearance. We anticipate that all students will diligently attend to their personal grooming and that uniforms are clean and in good condition worn in the manner intended. We have set down some guidelines that need to be adhered to, to ensure a high standard is met. We do, however understand that sometimes a situation may arise that will require special consideration. In this case you will need to consult with the appropriate Head of School to discuss your needs.

Whilst appearance is important, at Heatherton it is acknowledged that God judges the heart, not the outward appearance. Students should be distinctive in the community by their displayed Christlike attitude and behaviour, and not by an extraordinary standard of dress.

Students are required to conform to this policy at all times. Breaches of policy shall initially incur a warning. Ongoing breaches of policy without a letter of explanation shall result in appropriate corrective and/or disciplinary action.

ADDITIONAL UNIFORM NOTES

Nothing worn under the uniform is to be visible either through the fabric or at the neck/arm line, ie no t-shirts to be worn under the uniform.

Uniform items should be replaced or repaired when they are in poor condition, ill-fitting, otherwise unsuitable and/or inconsistent with this policy.

The length of all skirts and dresses must be no shorter than the horizontal crease in the back of the knee when standing in an upright position without wearing a jumper.

Jewellery,	Students are not permitted to wear jewellery (including rings, wrist/ankle bands
watches	and bracelets, necklaces can be worn but must not be visible) other than
and	
tattoos	Ear jewellery may be small studs, traditional sleepers, or plain round earrings no more than 1 cm in diameter and 1mm thick. Not more than two items may be worn in each ear. Ear jewellery must be removed for safety reasons as required.
	A single clear or flesh coloured small stud may be worn in a single nose piercing (for secondary school only). This should not be a piercing in the septal cartilage near the upper lip.
	Watches that do not bring undue attention are acceptable.
	Visible tattoos are not acceptable, including when students are wearing sports
	uniform or swimwear.
Make-up	Secondary students are permitted to wear a natural colour foundation and
and Nails	clear lip gloss or lip balm. Mascara and eyeliner are allowed on the provision



	that the overall look remains natural. Heavy eyeliner and the overuse of mascara will not be tolerated. Students found to be wearing excessive make- up or colours which do not fall into a more natural range will be asked to remove it. Coloured eye shadow, coloured lipstick or coloured lipgloss/balm or any type of glitter is not permitted. Nails
	The following restrictions apply to nails
	No coloured nail polish or fake nails
	No French nails, acrylics, SNS or gel nails
	Students with coloured nail polish will be asked to remove it. Students with fake nails will also be asked to have these removed or risk being asked not to return to school until such time that this is done. Secondary students may wear a clear nail polish.
Hair	Hair must be worn neatly, at all times. Shoulder length or longer hair that touches the bottom of the collar must be a tied back securely using a tie in College colours of maroon, navy, black and white.
	Exaggerated and fad hairstyles are not permitted, including unusual shaving or spiking of the hair. The College prefers that hair is not artificially coloured in
	any way. However, in Years 7-12, subtle highlights such as soft foils and tips in shades close to student's natural hair colour, are permitted. The overall effect should look natural.
	Students are expected to be clean shaven prior to arriving at school.
Coat and Scarves	Any style of coat in navy is acceptable to and from school. Scarves can be plain white, navy or maroon with no logo and signage.
Hat	It is compulsory to wear a school hat in the playground throughout Terms 1 and 4 for sun safety reasons.
Beanie	A Heatherton Christian College beanie can be worn during Term 2 and 3.
	This can be purchased at the College office when available or a plain navy
	beanie with no logo and signage may be worn. These are to only be worn
	outdoors and not in the classrooms.
School	The Heatherton Christian College backpack with school emblem and motto is

Labelling	All items of clothing need to be clearly labelled with the child's name. This
	includes hats, coats, bags, etc.
